



## Easy Steps to completing the SUFC online payment process

The 2019 SUFC Women's registration payments are now due. All registration fees are paid online. Please follow the below instructions carefully to ensure you are registered correctly;

Note - There are 3 registration options for 2019 depending on whether you are playing XVs, 7s or both.

1. Just playing XVs - **Cost - \$300**
2. Just playing 7s - **Cost - \$200**
3. Playing both XVs and 7s - **Cost - \$400**

- **Step 1** - Go to: <https://jaonline.sport.usyd.edu.au/>
- **Step 2** - Select the correct option that applies to you;
  - **University of Sydney Students** - if you are a current USYD student
  - **Community member** - if you are a graduate, not a student or a student at a different university
- **Step 3** - Complete your personal details
- **Step 4** - Select the correct playing option that applies to you, (scroll down through gym passes to the Club Membership – or search Rugby) either;
  - **Women's Rugby XVs**
  - **Women's Rugby 7s**
  - **Women's Rugby XVs and 7s**
- **Step 5** - You will be asked to pay a prerequisite SUSF Annual Membership payment on top of your SUFC registration fee, this membership provides access to SUSF facilities at casual user rates and is a requirement for joining any of the sports clubs. (\$50 for students currently enrolled at Sydney University or \$65 for players not students at Sydney University). **Please note**; students who are USYD college residents in 2019 will **NOT** need to pay this fee as it is covered by your college.
- **Step 6** - Read and agree to the Terms and Conditions
- **Step 7** - Answer the Adult pre-exercise screening tool questions
- **Step 8** - Enter your credit/debit card details to complete the registration
- **Step 9** - You will receive an email confirmation of your purchase from SUSF

**Please note** – *Your credit card statement will read Ezidebit Healthfit (not SUSF)*

No player will be able to represent SUFC until payment and all other registration steps are completed, this includes receiving kit.
